

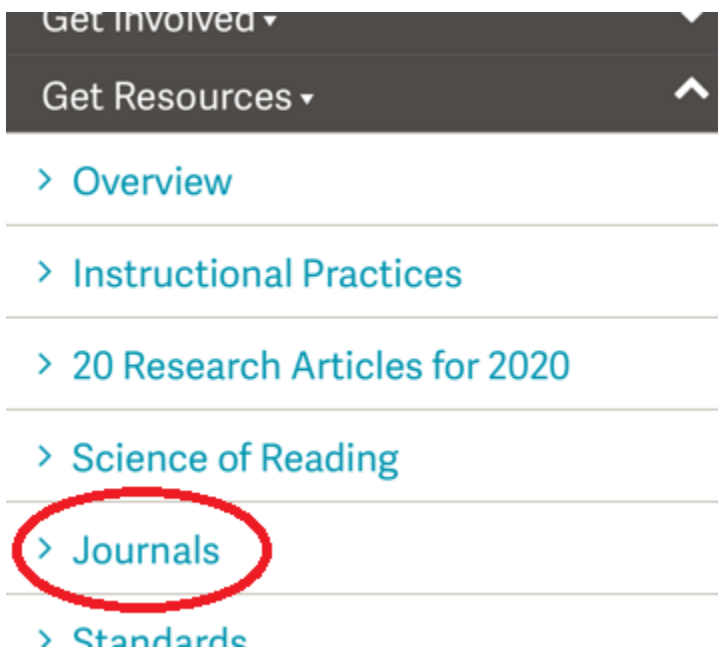
How to Access Your ILA Journals Online From Your Mobile Device

It's easy to access your ILA journals online from your phone or mobile device. Follow the steps below to log in and access your content.

Go to literacyworldwide.org and sign in at the top of the page with your ILA username and password:



Click **Get Resources** and then **Journals** from the drop-down menu:



Look for the title(s) to which you subscribe on the **Journals** page. (If you are not signed in, there will be a message asking you to sign in, which you can do at the top of the page.) Click **Read My Journal**.
