The **#MyBookVoice** project invites kids and teens from around the globe to share short, personal videos recommending a favorite read.

Make a short video (60–90 seconds)

Show the book (print or digital), then say:

- Your **first name** and **state** or **country** (no cities or schools).
- Your age (no birthdays, please!).
- "The book I chose is [TITLE] by [AUTHOR]."
- "This book is about..."
- "You should read it because..."

Post your video

Share (or ask an adult to share) on your favorite platform and **tag ILA**:

Include the book's title, author(s), and illustrator(s). You can also mention the genre and the age group you think will enjoy it most. **Don't forget to use #MyBookVoice in the caption!**

You can still participate!

- Teachers can share student-created book talks in class or the school library.
- Parents and caregivers can share privately or on a password-protected site.

Tips to shine

- Be yourself—energetic, honest, and spoiler-light.
- Record in a quiet, well-lit spot; hold the book where we can see it.
- Turn on captions if your platform allows.
- Safety first: First name only, no city/school details, and keep location services off.
