



READ-ALoud CHOICE BOARD

<p>Point out the author and illustrator.</p> <p>Together, check out the author and/or illustrator website to learn more about them!</p>	<p>Read the title together.</p> <p>Make a prediction about what the book might be about.</p>	<p>Do a picture walk to activate your interest in reading the story.</p> <p>What do you wonder?</p>
<p>Pause for 2–3 vocabulary words to discuss as you read.</p> <p>Work together to generate a definition for each vocabulary word.</p>	<p>Make a text-to-self connection.</p> <p>This can be a connection between the story and your own life.</p>	<p>Make a text-to-text connection.</p> <p>This can be a connection between the story and another book, TV/ movie, comic, recipe, song lyrics, or another kind of text.</p>
<p>Ask “what do you notice?”</p> <p>Discuss together!</p>	<p>If your child enjoyed this book, consider checking out other books by this author at your local library.</p> <p>If your child is interested in the topic, consider exploring other books on the subject.</p>	<p>Suggest possible writing connections such as writing a letter or journal entry to the main character.</p> <p>Write a poem inspired by a character in the book!</p>
